**1 Name of Declaration**

This Declaration is the *Telecommunications Numbering Plan Number Declaration 2004*.

**2 Commencement**

This Declaration commences on 5 July 2004.

**3. Freephone and local rate numbers available for allocation by auction**

(1) The freephone numbers and local rate numbers available for allocation by auction, as set out in Part 5 Division 7A of the *Telecommunications Numbering Plan 1997*, are:

(a) all 6 digit numbers that start with 13; and

- (b) all 10 digit numbers that start with 1300 or 1800, except the numbers described in subsection (2).

NOTE: See subsection 3.39(2) of the *Telecommunications Numbering Plan 1997*.

- (2) The freephone numbers and local rate numbers that are not available for allocation by auction are:

- (a) the 10 digit numbers for International Country Direct services, described in Part 6 of Schedule 1 to the *Telecommunications Numbering Plan Number Declaration 2000*, as in force at the commencement of this Declaration; and

- (b) the following 10 digit numbers:
