Schedule 1 Amendments

(section 3)

[1] **Schedule 1, definition of *PMTS Class B***

substitute

PMTS Class B means a Public Mobile Telecommunications Service Class B, being a service that consists of 2 or more land stations that are operated under a PTS licence.

[2] **Schedule 1, definition of *PTS licence***

substitute

PTS licence means an apparatus licence issued for a service that consists of 1 or more stations that are operated for the provision of a public mobile telecommunications service.
