

# DO YOU SELL OR RENT TWO-WAY RADIOS?

**LISTEN UP, THIS IS FOR YOU!**



If you sell or rent two-way radios with your licensed frequency pre-programmed into the radio, you **MUST** give your written authorisation to the customer—it can even be in the invoice or rental agreement.

## They should know:



The frequencies they're allowed to use



The duration of the authorisation



The location they're allowed to operate in



Any other conditions that must be met

As the licensee, you may be liable if the radio interferes with other services. And more importantly, **it could risk lives.**

Check the Register of Radiocommunications Licences at [acma.gov.au/licenceregister](http://acma.gov.au/licenceregister) or speak with the ACMA before you rent or sell. It's your responsibility to manage your clients ... it's the law!
