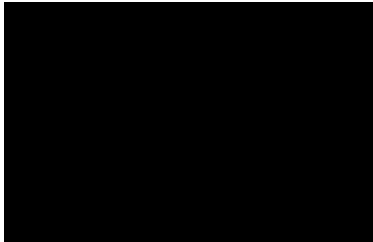

Hi,

I just got a SROCP (marine AMC-ACMA) ticket and received it in a driver's licence form - what a brilliant idea. It would be great if the AOCP and the callsign licence could be given in that form and if they could be backed up by databases which could be checked if necessary. I'm finding that a lot of licenses are done that way.



1) issue all amateur radio operators on passing the exam , and legacy holders on request, with their AOCP in card form.

2) construct a full database that lists the AOCP holders that is publicly accessible.

3) issue all amateur radio license holders on obtaining their license, and legacy holders on request, with their license in card form.

4) construct a full database that lists the license holders that is publicly accessible.

Use Cases

- 1) when travelling - taking equipment through customs.
- 2) purchasing and importing equipment.
- 3) going on amateur radio specific Internet networks.

Requirements

- 1) it must be clear that the operator has a valid AOCP.
- 2) it must be clear that the operator has a valid and current license.
- 3) these must be confirmable online.

Currently this is not the situation. At the moment it's rather a mess.
