**Re: Remaking the low interference potential devices class licence 2025**

Profiles RF Management Pty Ltd (PRM) is Australia's major RF Spectrum Management company for major broadcast and sporting events. PRM undertakes spectrum management for events that are high users of LIPD devices such as the NRL State of Origin matches, AFL Gather Round, NRL Grand Finals, AFL Grand Finals, Test Cricket, Melbourne Cup, Everest Carnival, Laneway music festival and Australia Day Celebrations on Sydney Harbour each year.

PRM supports the changes to the LIPD outlined in the above consultation. As a stakeholder in the live event and broadcast sector, we support the proposed measures that encourage the development of technologies that support efficient use of the spectrum that is a fundamental element of the products we use in our industry.

While there is some contention that allowing the use of 20MHz bandwidth has the potential for inefficient spectrum usage if a low number of active audio channels exist in a wide band device, we believe this is best overcome through diligent spectrum management at large events. PRM understands ACMA's desire to keep harmonised with European and US standards and support this.

Furthermore, we support the adoption of the European standards for conformity for the WMAS products. This ensures that it remains easier for products to be used in Australia.
