**Subject:** Submission on Review of the 700 MHz band spectrum licence technical framework

Apple appreciates the opportunity to provide comments via the public consultation— Review of the 700 MHz band spectrum licence technical framework (hereon as 'Reviews').

The review appear to propose Options B1 and B2 for issue 2 (Unwanted emission limit below 694 MHz) as follows,

- **Option B1, No change:** Keep the current unwanted emission limit below 694 MHz defined in terms of EIRP and retain a stricter limit in Block E areas.
- **Option B2, adoption of ETSI standard for Band 28:** Adopt the ETSI-specified unwanted emission limit below 694 MHz.



Apple proposes the preferred option is **Option B2**, that is, adoption of the ETSI-specified unwanted emission limits below 694 MHz as detailed in EN 301 908-13, as justified by all the justifications listed in the consultation document, and especially that this unwanted emission limit below 694 MHz would align with 3GPP standards, easing compliance requirements for suppliers.
