New National Anti-Corruption Commission (NACC) and Integrity in the ACMA

Late last year the Australian Parliament passed legislation creating the [National Anti-Corruption Commission \(NACC\)](#), which will commence operations on 1 July 2023. The NACC will play an important role in the Commonwealth's multi-faceted integrity framework, with broad jurisdiction to investigate public sector corruption.

The Attorney-General's Department (AGD) has released a set of initial fact sheets about the NACC covering:

- a broad [overview of the NACC](#) and the legislation that will underpin its day-to-day work
- an outline of the NACC's [jurisdiction](#) in investigating corruption
- information and examples of the [definition of corrupt conduct](#) for the purposes of the *National Anti-Corruption Commission Act 2022*.
