I am reaching out as the APS Disability Champion and Chair of the APS Disability Champions Network (DCN) with the hope to engage your support in the important work of the Network.

The DCN is comprised of senior executive level members from APS agencies who meet quarterly to drive positive change for people with disability across the APS. The purpose of the DCN is to bring together senior level advocates to actively champion, advocate for, and steward disability employment.

I see the role of the DCN as vital in driving and positively influencing change within the APS for people with disability. To achieve this, the DCN requires SES who are engaged, active, and willing to contribute their time, energy and expertise.
