### Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Voice

On Saturday, 14 October 2023, Australians will have their say in a [referendum](#) about whether to change the Constitution to recognise the First Peoples of Australia by establishing a body called the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Voice.

Now that the referendum date has been confirmed, it is timely to remind ourselves of previous advice from the APSC and the Chair about our obligations as public servants when engaging in matters relating to the referendum in a personal capacity to ensure that public confidence in the integrity of the APS is maintained.

There are also some strict rules on procurement activities that may, or may be perceived to be, supporting or not supporting the referendum. If you have any questions about your procurement activities as they relate to the referendum, please contact our Procurement Team at [REDACTED]
