Your participants Diploma studies will commence in February 2023 or March 2023 (depending on which group they are placed in and will end in September 2023. Please see attached the CIT training calendars for your participant(s) which includes their training schedule and provides an overview of the courses they will be studying. These courses include:

- APS writing skills
- Foundations of Government
- Complex communications, negotiation, and conflict
- Client services
- Change in the public sector
- Emotional intelligence

Participants have now received correspondence containing details in relation to the Diploma of Government studies, with calendar invites soon to follow. The training consists of 14 facilitated learning days, four assessment workshops and six learner support sessions. Participation in the facilitated learning days and assessment workshops is **mandatory** component of the IAGDP.

These sessions provide additional study time, with a facilitator available to answer any questions or concerns that participants may have regarding their assessments.
