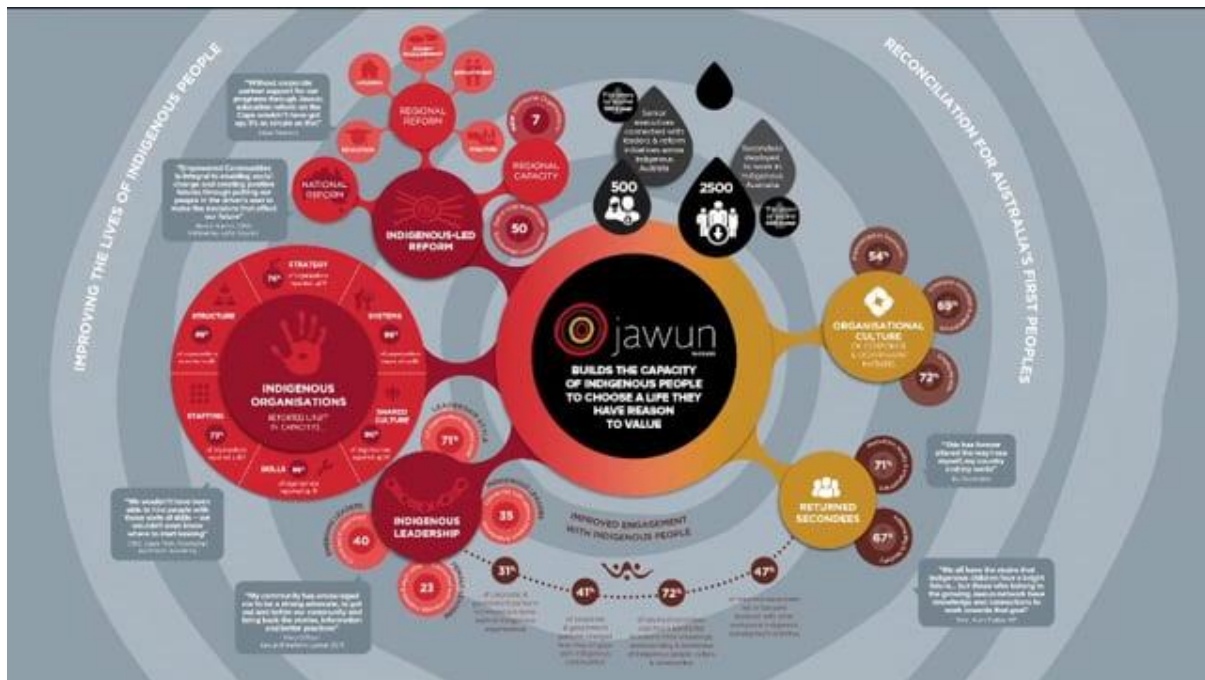
Jawun is a unique and life changing experience that places Australian Public Service (APS) secondees with Indigenous communities for a two-way learning experience. Find out more about the program, which is available in-person or virtually, and if you are eligible to apply.

Jawun is a strategic partnership that supports Indigenous leaders to achieve their development goals. Working in partnership with government, corporate and not-for-profit partners, Jawun also provides opportunity to develop APS leadership capabilities.

The [Jawun APS Secondment Program](#) provides the opportunity to share knowledge, culture and experiences, while providing the opportunity to learn and transfer skills:
