6KCR is pleased to be able to respond to the ACMA Consultation Paper.

Whilst ideally 6KCR would like to remain on the 102.5 FM frequency that it has occupied since first being granted a permanent licence in 2002 and will experience some difficulties in retaining all our listeners, we appreciate the need for the ABC to move its AM band stations to the FM wave band to provide an improved service to the whole population of the Perth Metropolitan area.

Having been granted an increase in transmission tower height to 35 metres which should improve our coverage in currently difficult areas of our Licence Area Plan (LAP), 6KCR supports the proposals in the ACMA Paper.
