RE: Proposal to amend equipment regulation for electric vehicles: Tesla Submission

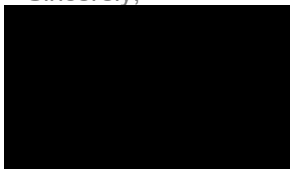
Dear Manager,

Tesla Motors Australia, Pty Ltd (**Tesla**) fully supports the proposal to amend the Radiocommunications Equipment (General) Rules 2021 to provide new exemptions from compliance with the Radiocommunications (Electromagnetic Compatibility) Standard 2017 (**EMC standard**) to exempt Electric Vehicle Council (**EVC**) members from:

1. Labelling certain motor vehicle parts, components and aftermarket vehicle equipment that comply with mandated electromagnetic energy (EME) and radiocommunications general standards (where applicable).
2. Requirements in the EMC standard and the Radiocommunications Labelling (Electromagnetic Compatibility) Notice 2017 (**EMC labelling notice**) if their vehicle complies with a Voluntary Code of Practice for Electromagnetic Compatibility of Motor Vehicles developed by the EVC (the **EVC code**).

With the introduction of electric vehicles to the Australian market, the EVC has emerged as a national body representing the electric vehicle industry. Given existing exemptions that already apply to other industry bodies, this proposal will ensure regulatory neutrality in equipment regulation and remove potential barriers to trade for electric vehicle suppliers by expanding existing exemptions to also cover EVC members.
