## Investigation into whether Sportsbet broadcast and provided in-play betting during the Brownlow Medal Count

The Australian Communications and Media Authority (ACMA) has conducted an investigation into a complaint received alleging that Sportsbet Pty Ltd (Sportsbet) contravened the *Interactive Gambling Act 2001* (IGA) by advertising and providing in-play betting during the Brownlow Medal Count broadcast on Channel 7 on 18 September 2022.

The investigation considered whether Sportsbet:

- > provided a prohibited interactive gambling service, in the form of an online in-play sports betting service, to customers in Australia in contravention of subsection 15(2A) of the IGA.
- > broadcast a designated interactive gambling service advertisement in Australia in contravention of subsection 61DA(1A) or authorised, or caused, a designated interactive gambling service advertisement to be broadcast in Australia in contravention of subsection 61DA(3) of the IGA.

*In-Play betting service*

Section 10B of the IGA provides that a gambling service is an *in-play betting service* to the extent to which:

- (a) *the service relates to betting on the outcome of a sporting event, where the bets are placed, made, received or accepted after the beginning of an event; or*
- (b) *the service relates to betting on a contingency that may or may not happen in the course of a sporting event, where the bets are placed, made, received or accepted after the beginning of the event.*

The IGA does not include a definition of a sporting event. Therefore, the ACMA has considered its ordinary meaning and determined that in terms of the IGA, the Brownlow Medal Count is not a sporting event itself.

The ACMA also found that the outcome of the count which is determined by votes awarded by umpires at the conclusion of each match, is not a contingency that happens in the course of a sporting event.

For these reasons the ACMA has found that Sportsbet did not offer a prohibited interactive gambling service, in the form of in-play betting during the Brownlow Medal Count.

*Designated gambling service advertisement*

The definition of a designated gambling service (section 4) in the IGA is:

- (a) a prohibited interactive gambling service: or
- (b) an unlicensed regulated interactive gambling service

Given the finding that Sportsbet did not offer a prohibited interactive gambling service, it follows that Sportsbet did not broadcast a designated interactive gambling service advertisement in Australia in contravention of subsection 61DA(1A) or authorise, or cause, a designated interactive gambling service advertisement to be broadcast in Australia in contravention of subsection 61DA(3) of the IGA.

*Consideration of betting on other awards relating to sporting events*

As part of the investigation, we also considered betting markets offered by Sportsbet on the winner of the Norm Smith medal and the Clive Churchill medal.

We note that these awards are made based on the performance of players during an individual match, with the award winner selected and announced at the conclusion of the event by officials or independent persons. The selection of the winner is not dependant on the outcome of the sporting event.

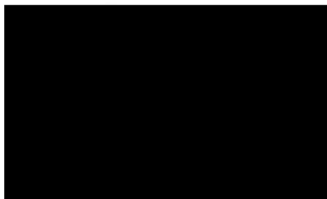
The ACMA did not consider these awards which are determined at the conclusion of the event to be a sporting event, or a contingency which may or may not happen in the course of a sporting event.

The ACMA intends to publish the findings of this investigation as it will have educative value for other wagering operators and consumers. We will also include information on our findings in the ACMA gambling e-bulletin.
